

Morrow Middle School 2018 - 2019 Dress Code

Morrow Middle School is a "uniform school". Student's clothing, make-up and hairstyles should reflect neatness, cleanliness and self-respect so that the school is a desirable place to promote learning and character development. We continue to highlight the importance of school safety by designating student grade levels by shirt color. This will enable us to keep a visual watch over all students as they learn and maintain their day to day activities. Thank you for your help in making this another wonderful year here at Morrow Middle School.

Tops: Shirts (All shirts must have a collar and be tucked into bottom of choice).

Shirt Styles: Solid Polo and/or Oxford button down style. No Stripes or Patterns.

Suggested Colors: 6th Grade – Solid White

7th Grade - Solid Gold or Solid Yellow



8th Grade - Solid Hunter or Dark Green If students wear any of the Morrow school colors it will not be considered a uniform violation

Sweaters/sweatshirts: Without a hood should match the appropriate grade level colors. Sweaters or sweatshirts should be school colors white, gold or green. <u>No hoods, stripes or patterns allowed</u>. Students may be granted a reasonable accommodation when approved by the principal.

Bottoms: Pants, shorts, skirts, capris, skorts

Sizes: Please do not purchase pants that are more than 2 sizes larger than your child's natural waist size. Bottom style selection must be worn at the waist with a belt if garment has belt loops.

Colors:

ors: Pants/Shorts Khaki/Tan

Belt: Standard Black or Brown with standard buckle, also school colors allowed (khaki, gold or Hunter green).

Shoes: No Flip-Flops, shower shoes, skate shoes, mesh styled mules/ballet shoes or house slippers are permitted.

- ✓ Uniforms are worn during the entire school day.
- ✓ Coats are to be placed in lockers. Coats <u>may not</u> be worn during the school day.
- ✓ Sweaters and coats must be school uniform colors.
- ✓ Skirts, skirts, shorts should be fingertip length. Jeggings/Leggings are not allowed.
- ✓ No chains on pants.
- \checkmark Jeans are only permitted on designated days and must be denim blue with no rips or tears.
- ✓ Traditional fit applies to clothing. Oversized, saggy or too tight clothing will not be allowed.
- ✓ Sanctioned school logo attire for Morrow Middle School may be worn at any time.
- ✓ Undershirts/thermals worn under collared shirts must be white or solid school colors.
- Sweaters must be cardigan style (button up) in Solid colors of black, white, kaki, gold, yellow or hunter green.
 Kelly green is not acceptable.
- Hoodies <u>are not</u> allowed during the school day and must be placed in a locker at the beginning of the school day.
- ✓ Uniform accessories (ties, ribbons, hair bows, etc.) must be in solid black or solid school colors of white, khaki, gold or hunter green.

Please note, CCPS has a Dress and Grooming guide in the Student Handbook/Code of Conduct. Our uniform dress policy meets and exceeds the standards outlined in this document. If students wear any of the Morrow Middle school color polos they will not be considered in violation of the uniform dress code.
